The Ontario County Traffic Safety Board met for its summer meeting on August 10, 2016. Several presentations were given including the 2nd Quarter "Top Cop" award given to Ontario County Sheriff's Deputy Dustin Heininger. Deputy Heininger was recognized for the number and quality of his DWI arrests. Other presenters included District Attorney R. Michael Tantillo who announced that Ontario County again had the highest conviction rating in New York State at 93.39%. David Adams, past president of the New York State Association for Pupil Transportation presented the Traffic Safety Board with the 2016 Law Enforcement Partnership Award. The morning ended with a powerful presentation given by Sarah Palermo, one of Ontario County's Victim Impact Panel speakers.
